

UFP-Treated CCA Limited Warranty

IMPORTANT: This is your warranty certificate. Attach your invoice and proof of warranty.

ELIGIBILITY

This Warranty is valid for standard residential applications and may not be assigned or transferred by you. The applicable Warranty Period is indicated on the product label or end tag. If there is no other indication, a One-Year Limited Warranty applies.

LIMITED WARRANTY

Warrantor will replace any genuine UFP-Treated CCA product used in a residential application which becomes structurally unfit due solely to damage caused by fungal decay or termites.

WARRANTY DETAILS

This Warranty does not cover costs of installation, removal, or reinstallation, or for the natural characteristic of some wood to split, warp or twist. Nor does it cover damage caused by physical abuse, acts of God, acts of war, or other chemical or biological factors. Warrantor's sole obligation is limited to replacement of the treated product, and Warrantor shall have no further liability or obligation except as expressly stated herein. The Warranty does not apply to any of the following uses: foundation piles, poles, supports in pole-frame structures, fence posts, swimming pool sidewalls, tree, vine or plant supports, use in commercial or industrial projects or any application involving immersion of the product in water.

Always follow the guidelines stated in the applicable Consumer Safety Information Sheet/Section when working with or handling this product. Warrantor reserves the right to investigate any claim and to inspect the materials on which a claim is made. Warrantor is not responsible for any application of the product other than that specified as the appropriate usage on the product end tag (e.g. "Above Ground Use Only" or "Not For Structural Use").

For Western species of wood (described in the Western Wood Products Association Grading Rules), this Warranty is invalid unless all end cuts and bore holes are end-coated during construction with a suitable wood preservative.

Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts and/or do not allow the exclusion of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitations and exclusions may not apply to you. This Warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

CLAIM PROCEDURE

To make a claim under this Warranty to receive replacement wood, the original owner must, within 90 days of actual or constructive notice of fungal or termite damage, do the following:

1. Prepare a letter that includes the following information:
 - a. A list of the number of pieces and the size of each piece for which the claim is made.
 - b. Proof of Purchase of the product, as shown on the original invoice.
 - c. Proof of Warranty, as evidenced by the original product label, or a copy of the mark on the product.
